For example, recently I was able to help a Nepali congregation get back into their church facility following COVID-19 delays, 1 month earlier than expected. I called the church on their behalf, explaining the safety and health of their congregants who are

largely Smithfield employees, and their need to be back together soon.

- I have broad experience in outreach—chaplaincy, visiting in the jail or prison, visiting on the streets and in the parks, helping in stores. Let me know if you have questions on visiting those who are incarcerated, or if you

are looking for ideas in doing Gospel outreach. If you do not see something in the list above about which you have a question or need, don’t hesitate to ask me. I am happy to try to find answers and solutions. As is written at the top of this newsletter, you “are reaching the world.” Your churches are often GATEWAYS to a world with so much need, especially for the Gospel. I am excited to help you in doing this important work!
